## GENERAL CONDITIONS

**RULES:** The Show is conducted under the Rules and Regulations of the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show Society Incorporated and the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies.

**SAFETY AND SECURITY:** The Society takes all reasonable care in these matters. Please refer to the following "Notice to Ground Users", and the Safety Regulations listed therein. The Society engages the services of Security Personnel to assist with the provision of care of all exhibits, livestock and property, but no responsibility can be accepted for loss or damage to or by such exhibits, livestock and / or property.

**WAIVER:** Every person that is involved in an activity during the Show is required by our insurer to sign a waiver. This includes riders, volunteers, trade exhibitors, entertainers etc.

**LOST PERSONS:** "Lost" persons, or those seeking "lost" persons are asked to wait on the roadside outside the Police Room. Public Address announcements will be made as deemed necessary.

**EARLY ENTRIES:** The lodgement of early entry forms for all Sections of the Show will greatly assist Stewards and Office staff in the smooth running of the Show.

**DATES:** Please note that dates quoted in this Schedule, e.g. 20th May, 30th June, refer to the year of this Show, as per dates on the front page of this Schedule.

**PRIZE MONEY:** All prize money will be available for collection from the Cashier at the Treasury, located beside the Main Office at the following times:

**Friday between the hours of 10.00am and 6.00pm only**

**Saturday between the hours of 9.00am and 6.00pm only**

**Sunday between the hours of 9.00am and 7.30pm only**

**Funds will also be available on the Monday after the Show from the Show Office between 9.00am and 12 noon.**

The exception to this arrangement is for Show Horses and Show Jumping for the Saturday events which will be available after the Grand Parade at 3.00pm on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> June. Ring event prize-winners are asked to note that prize money will NOT be paid on the Saturday of the Show until after the competitors have participated in the Grand Parade. Each competitor must produce a ticket to prove participation. Cheques cannot be posted as a receipt is required for each payment.

**UNCLAIMED PRIZE MONEY:** Prize money and trophies not claimed by the 30th June 2018 will be regarded as forfeited unless alternative arrangements have been made prior to this date.

**LIVESTOCK:** All livestock must enter the Showgrounds via the Bli Bli Road Gates and exit via the Crushers exit. Poultry entries will have a dedicated lane at the front gate for delivery and collection of their exhibits.

**NOTICE TO GROUND USERS:** The duration of the 2018 Show includes set up time pre-Show and pack-up post - Show. (The period 8<sup>th</sup> June to 20<sup>th</sup> June 2018 inclusive).

**SAFETY REGULATIONS:** This is a Safety Conscious Show and it is your Show. Please help to keep it safe and accident free. Normal rules and regulations of the Workplace Health and Safety Act, Sunshine Coast Council and the Show Society apply.

The Society requests the total co-operation of all Exhibitors, Competitors and Patrons in the following matters as these are requirements of our insurers and / or the Showground Management for the duration of the 2018 Sunshine Coast Show.

1. Your co-operation is sought in reporting to the Show Safety Officer or Show Manager any situation you may consider a potential hazard or danger.
2. The Show Safety Officer, or Nominee, has the power to instruct any Ground User to comply with the Society's requirements at all times.

3. All heavy vehicles and floats must be parked in designated areas as directed by parking stewards. Owners / drivers are reminded that offenders of this requirement and those who indulge in excessive speed could be responsible for serious consequences in the event of an emergency.
4. Whilst all reasonable care is taken, the Society cannot accept any responsibility for any losses of, or damage or injury to or by, any livestock, exhibits, equipment, vehicles or any other property.
5. Trade exhibitors are asked to note that set-up is not to commence before Thursday, 14<sup>th</sup> June and all exhibits and related display equipment, trailers, buildings, etc. must be removed from the grounds by Tuesday, 19<sup>th</sup> June at the latest.
6. The Trade Site Coordinator will oversee Trade Exhibitors who are also asked to take all reasonable care in the case of working machinery, hydraulics, cables, chemicals, pumps, hoses, pools, power tools, saws, ramps, etc. All electrical leads and appliances must meet Workplace Health and Safety standards, in particular the requirement for all leads to be buried 75mm underground or be at least 2 metres aboveground. All electrical equipment that comes onto the grounds must have a current test and tag label attached or the equipment cannot be used. These requirements will be monitored by the District Workplace Health and Safety inspector.
7. Dogs are **not** permitted in the Showgrounds at any time unless it is a Guide or Companion Dog. Any dog found will be impounded as per Council regulations.
8. Government regulations re Smoking
  - no-smoking in commercial outdoor eating or drinking areas
  - **To comply with these regulations there will be no smoking on the grounds other than in signed designated areas set aside specifically for smoking.**

**MEMBERSHIP:** Adult Membership is open to anyone with the annual Fee being set at \$40.00 per person which is due to be paid by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018. Junior Memberships are also available for anyone under the age of 18 years (as at the date of the 2018 Show) with the Annual Fee being set at \$15.00 per person.

**Cattle are encouraged to arrive on the grounds on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> June (due to limited unloading space) however loading ramps will not close until 7.30am Friday 15<sup>th</sup> June. Trucks must be parked by 7.50am on Friday in order for the gates to be opened to the public. This will be strongly policed. Please direct any questions about this to the chief steward.**

**PLEASE NOTE: All Exhibitors must parade in the Grand Parade on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> June at 2.00pm. Failure to do so will mean that any prize money will be forfeited.**

### **PLEASE READ SCHEDULE CAREFULLY AS CONDITIONS MAY HAVE CHANGED**

1. The Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show abides by a **JBAS Level 6** rating.
2. The Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show Society Inc adopts the QCAS rules as part of their rules. These rules are the rules of our Show.
3. All entries to be completed online at [www.sunshinecoastshow.asn.au](http://www.sunshinecoastshow.asn.au) and must be lodged by 5.00pm on Friday 8th June 2018.
4. When entering please ensure that your Stud Name is entered under “Company” and the name of your animal under the “Exhibit”.
5. All entry fees to be paid online for entries to be accepted.

6. Nominations will not be accepted unless gate entry or membership is paid with entries and waiver form is signed.
7. Camping may be available in the area behind the cattle shed.
8. Copy of Public Liability Insurance to be provided prior to the Show.
9. All cattle to be on the Showgrounds by 7.30am on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> June 2018. NLIS Scanning of all cattle will be completed by 11.30am on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> June 2018.
10. All cattle must enter the Showgrounds via the Bli Bli Road Cates only. All cattle to be unloaded at ramps as directed by the Stewards. **All vehicles are to be parked at Crushers Grounds** (monitored by security). **Exit is by Crushers Grounds only.** Any cattle vehicles parked in the Horse Float Parking area will be towed.
11. All Show Cattle must be tick free to enter the Showgrounds.
12. No Stud Beef Cattle will be admitted to the grounds unless thoroughly tractable.
13. All cattle must be bona fide property of the Exhibitor for three (3) months prior to the Show.
14. All ribboned exhibits must be led in the Grand Parade. Failure to do so may lead to disqualification.
15. Whilst all reasonable care is taken, the Society cannot accept any responsibility for any losses of, or damage or injury to or by, any livestock, exhibits, equipment, vehicles or any other property.
16. All exhibitors who participate in the Show Ring **MUST wear dust jackets or Society approved uniform at all times** when their animal is presented to the Judge.
17. **Any exhibitors/competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited and all power boards must be tested and tagged.**
18. No dispute will be considered whilst the event is in progress. Protests are to be lodged in writing within thirty (30) minutes after the Class in dispute is completed and must be handed to the Show Secretary accompanied with a fee of \$50. The dispute committee will consist of three (3) Management Committee members and their decision will be final.
19. It is forbidden to administer any prohibited drug or cause one to be administered in any way whatsoever. A prohibited drug means any substance originating externally to the animal (whether or not endogenous to the animal) capable of affecting the performance or behaviour of any animal by its action upon central or peripheral nervous system, the cardiovascular system, the respiratory system, the alimentary system, the musculo-skeletal system or the uro-genital system and shall include analgesics, anti-histamines, anti-inflammatory agents, blood coagulants, diuretics, hormones and their synthetic counterparts, cortico-steroids, anabolic steroids, local anaesthetics, muscle relaxants and tranquillizers. Any exhibit which has been brought to the Showgrounds and is found to have had administered to it any prohibited drug as defined above may, without prejudice to any other action which may be taken in respect of the matter, be debarred by the Show Stewards from competing in any event for which it may have been entered.
20. No drug, hormone or tranquillizer shall be administered to any animal exhibit except under the direction of the Society's Veterinary Surgeon who will advise the Stewards if in their opinion, such drug, hormone or

tranquillizer is likely to have any effect upon the animal which would be material to its chances of being awarded a prize and in such case the Stewards may debar the animal from competing. In Prime Cattle, growth promotion substance is permitted.

21. A Show Steward may, at any time, direct the Society's Veterinary Surgeon to take a sample of blood, saliva or urine from an exhibit for testing. Any testing carried out is definitely at the expense of the exhibitor or owner of the exhibit.
22. All Entry Fees stated in the schedule include GST.
23. All Exhibitors must pay the GST inclusive Entry Fees whether they are registered for GST purposes or not. All prize money stated in the schedule includes GST.
24. Exhibitors are not permitted to interfere with the judging process.
25. There is no limit of the number of entries which may be made by an exhibitor;
26. Every care will be taken of exhibits but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage;
27. To comply with insurance all entrants must complete a Waiver (attached & available on website);
28. All entries are subject to QCAS Special Stud Beef & Prime Beef rules;
29. The age of the animal is to be the actual age as of 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2018;
30. All cattle must be registered in the herd book of their breed society;
31. All animals must be haltered and totally tractable at all times. **Bulls over 12 months of age must be led with nose ring** and all other cattle over 6 months must be led with a nose grip or nose ring;
32. All animals **must** be tied neck strap whilst in their stalls;
33. Exhibitor's group entries must include 3 animals and must consist of both sexes. Animals entered in the Pair of Males and Pair of Females must be owned by the exhibitor;
34. Animals under 12 months of age may be exhibited with their dam as one unit **OR** they may compete as an individual in their appropriate classes;
35. All cattle must comply with the health test requirements of Brucellosis and Tuberculosis;
36. Prize money given only after the grand parade;
37. Any exhibitor that fails to participate in grand parade will forfeit prize money;
38. No late entries accepted;
39. Each exhibit intro must state full particulars of each animal entered. Name in full, sire, dam, herd book number and date of birth.

**PRIZE MONEY:** All prize money will be available for collection from the Cashier at the Treasury, located beside the Main Office as soon as possible after 3.00pm on the Saturday of the Show. Cheques cannot be posted as a receipt is required for each payment. Prizes not collected by 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018 will be forfeited.

**DISCLAIMER:** The Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show Society (SCASS) shall not be responsible for any accident that may be caused to or by an exhibitor, members of the general public or competitor and will not, under any circumstances, be responsible for any losses or non-delivery of livestock or entries of any kind, or any injury or damage done thereby. Persons contravening any of SCASS's rules/regulations shall forfeit any prize awarded. SCASS reserves the right to refuse or cancel, or require any entry to be removed at any time. Exhibitors shall accept the decision of the Stewards/Judges appointed by SCASS as final. **The decisions of the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show Society Committee are final.**
