Rules & Conditions

1. All competitors ride at their own risk. Safety approved helmet be worn at all times while mounted.
2. Only Mares and Geldings may compete.
3. Committee has the right to alter, delete or combine any classes or classes as it sees fit, and to remove any Horse or Pony it considers dangerous.
4. Plaiting and Jackets optional. Otherwise Pony Club jerseys or plain sweatshirts may be worn in all rings.
5. No responsibility taken for any damage or loss of personal property.
6. Snaffle bits only for showing classes.
7. No changing of classes after close of entries.
8. Ribbons 1st to 6th in showing classes. Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded to the combination with the most points in their section. In the event of a tie the highest placed in the rider class will be the winner.
9. Showing Judges will rotate around the main rings. Each class type will be judged by a different judge. Bell will be rung after 15 mins to change judges. Committee and Judges have the right to ask a competitor to leave the arenas for the welfare of the horse. (Unfit, unwell, unsound, unruly and unsuitable to compete. NZPCA yellow cards apply.
10. Owner must be able to produce some verification of height (no more than 2 years old) If a query is asked.
11. No horse /pony or rider to be under 4 years of age (as on the day).Riders to be 16 years and under if riding in the Pony Section.
12. Neither the Organisers nor any persons acting on their behalf accept liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to ponies, horses, and riders or other persons or property whatsoever.
13. Sections A - H No balance or grass reins.
- 14 No Go Pro to be used when Jumping. Jumping competitors may ride only in ONE Ring
- 15 All entrants must read and sign that they understand the Hazards on the grounds.

NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS: Strictly adhered to. .

BEGINNER RIDER: Riders 14 years and under who are not yet capable of cantering in a group. The same combination may not enter in both the Lead Rein Section and the Beginner Rider, but the same mount may be entered in both with a different rider.

The committee reserves the right to transfer riders who appear to be in the wrong section.

LEAD REIN: Riders must not ride off the lead during the show.

ONLY BACK NUMBERS SUPPLIED BY ORGANISING COMMITTEE TO BE USED:

No charge for Back Numbers but a penalty of \$20 will be payable if numbers are not returned.

REFUNDS: Written application by the 24th February, accompanied by a Vet or Doctors Certificate less 20% Administration Fee.

PROTESTS: must be accompanied by a cash deposit of \$40 and in writing no later than ½ hour after the incident occurring.

Directions: Heading through Ashburton on the main highway until you reach Moore Street intersection (McDonalds & Mega Mitre 10) turn over the railway line into Moore Street and travel through on roundabout (Chalmers Ave). Continue into Beach Road. The last street on the town boundary is Trevors Road, turn right and Mill Creek Grounds are located just after the road goes from seal to shingle.

RING ONE

Two phase round, clear over first phase and within the time, ride the second phase against the clock. Two sets of flags are used. Three refusals or a fall is elimination.

Competitors entering the same height twice will be Non Competitive the second round. Two phase competition- judged under ESNZ rules, Article 274.5.3
