### **Rules of Entry:**

Where live cattle or deer form part of a trade display the exhibitor is responsible for:

(i) Ensuring all stock have completed all TB testing requirements as per Animal Health Board testing regulations.

(ii) Ensuring all stock are identified in accordance with current legal requirements.

Inspection: The Committee reserves the right to inspect at random any cattle for identification to establish TB Status. Bulls over 12 months old must be ringed.

**Prize Money:** 1st: \$15, 2nd: \$10, 3rd: \$5

Where entries in each class are 3 or less only half the prize money will be paid out
