CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS FOR CATTLE SECTIONS

To be read in conjunction with General Conditions of the Canterbury A&P Association and with the Rules and By-Laws of the Royal Agricultural Society.

ENTRIES CLOSE: FRIDAY 9 October 2020.

MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTIONS (GST included): Family, Corporate and Stud Membership \$105 (\$95 with a Farmlands card), Individual \$60 (\$55 with a Farmlands card), Junior \$30

Entry Fees: Members \$18, Non-Members \$35 (GST included)

Pen Fees: A Cow with calf at foot is classed as one animal.

Beef Cattle - \$15 per animal



C.1: All cattle entered in the Purebred Classes must be entered in the recognised Herd Books of the respective breeds, or if under one year of age they must be eligible for entry. The names of all Purebred Cattle must be stated in the entry form. This rule will be rigidly adhered to.

C.2: All cattle must be tattooed or marked in accordance with their respective Breed Society Rules otherwise they will be disqualified.

C.3: The registered number of the exhibited animal entered in the Purebred Classes must be given at time of entry, but registered numbers of Sire and Dam are not required. Breeding details will not be printed in the catalogue; however details are required for the entry form for verification of eligibility. In the case of young cattle where the registered number of the animal is not available, the date of birth and the name of sire and dam must be given.

C.4: Exhibitors must state the breeder's name.

C.5: The owner of the dam of an animal at the date of mating shall be considered the breeder.

C.6: All Cattle must be on the ground and stalled by 8pm Wednesday, the day prior to judging. All cattle are required to remain on the ground until after final judging on Thursday afternoon - unless otherwise given permission.

C.7: Cattle arriving late will be liable to disqualification.

C.8: The same animal cannot be entered in two Classes unless the contrary is specified.

C.9: Exhibits competing in the family and group classes must be entered in other classes.

C.10: The age of all Cattle, including calves at foot, is determined from 1st June each year with the exception of children's calf classes.

C.11: All exhibits must be shown up to their respective ages, and no two-year-old animal may be shown as a three-year-old, and no yearling may be shown in a two or three-year-old class. This applies to all sections.

Replacements

C.12: Notwithstanding Rule 15 of the General Conditions and Regulations of the Canterbury A&P Association, when an animal has been duly entered and catalogued in any class but cannot be paraded, it may be replaced provided notification is given to the Cattle Supervisor and providing it is the property of the Exhibitor concerned as stated in Rule 2 of the General Conditions. The replacement must meet entry criteria for TB and been tested clear. Breeding data is to be displayed on the stall.

Identification

C.13: T.B. Testing. All cattle entered for showing must be from a current TB Clear Status Herd. A copy of the current TB test certificate must be emailed to the office. The Canterbury A&P Association must be notified at the time of entry of any testing to be carried out after the closing date of entries or of any potential TB issues that may arise after entries have been submitted. Owners entering cattle must sign the declaration printed on the entry form. There are now two documents required under Animal Health Board and Canterbury A&P Committee regulations - TB Test Certificate: For cattle from a Declared Movement Controlled Areas - All Cattle aged 3 months or older are to be TB tested, and have a clear test within 60 days prior to being moved to the Show. All other cattle must be from a herd that is up to date with its current routine TB testing requirements. TB Animal Status Declaration Cards: This is a legal requirement for all cattle being moved. All cattle entered for this Show must be accompanied in transit by a signed and dated TB Animal Status Declaration Card showing a TB Clear status in accordance with present legislation. Animal individual numbers must be included on the TB test sheet. These cards will be inspected at the unloading area. For cattle being



moved from 1 July 2012: A NAIT approved RFID tag will be mandatory for all movements of cattle, including day old calves. NAIT approved RFID cattle tags are white only. Please do not remove tags if cattle are identified with Animal Health Board or MINDA tags. As of 1 July 2012 a secondary tag is no longer required under the new NAIT scheme. All animals being exhibited at the Show including any participating in a hoof and hook carcass competition comes under the standard identification and ASD regulations. These cattle will require the NAIT approved RFID tag. It is the livestock exhibitors responsibility to record all animal movements with NAIT 48 hours prior to leaving the farm/property for the Show and then within 48 hours of returning to the farm/property from the Show. Canterbury A&P Association - NAIT National Number: 454698. Where live cattle or deer form part of a trade display the exhibitor is responsible for: i. ensuring all stock have completed all TB testing requirements as per Animal Health Board testing regulations, ii. ensuring all stock are identified in accordance with current legal requirements.

Inspection

C.14: The Canterbury A&P Committee reserves the right to inspect at random any cattle for tattoos or identification to establish TB Status, or to detect any malpractice of presentation in Dairy Cattle (see Condition C.37)

Judging

C.15: Exhibits being presented in the ring for judging without the allocated NECK NUMBER, will be disqualified from the class.

C.15A: If an exhibitor has more than two animals they must have an appropriate number of handlers so they are not holding up proceedings.

PRESENTATION OF EXHIBITS/EXHIBITORS DURING JUDGING AND PARADES

No distinguishing mark of ownership or stud name, with the exception of 'earmarks, tattoos, ear tags' and registered brands may be attached to the animal exhibited. Exhibitors are requested to see that all leaders of cattle in judging rings and parades are to wear Breed Uniform or white coats - no exceptions. White coats are available for use from the Cattle Office.

Award Of Championships

Rural Livestock Ltd presents each Beef Breed with a Magnum of Lindauer for the "Personality" of each breed.

C.16: Champion and Reserve Champion will be selected as follows: First Prize winners in all eligible Classes to be paraded before the judge. Immediately the Champion has been selected the second prize animal in the Class from which the Champion has been selected shall parade with the others for Reserve Champion.

C.18: Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded at the Judge's discretion.

C.20: SPONSORSHIPS are subject to confirmation.

Parading

C.21: A Parade of ALL Cattle will be held on Thursday. **In any livestock parade children aged under 12 years leading cattle are to be accompanied by an adult. Any animal 2 years or over must be led by a person aged 16 years and over.**

C.22: All led bulls (born before 31 December last) must have a ring through the nose and be under adequate supervision. It is recommended that all Beef Females be led by a nose clip. Nose clips recommended on all beef yearling heifers from 2013, and COMPULSARY from 2014.

C.23: Bulls in the Cattle Pavilion must be securely tied by an adequate chain around the neck or



a stout leather collar with an adequate rope attached, as well as a halter, unless securely penned (closed gate).

Unruly Animals

C.24: The Canterbury A&P Association, through the Chairman of its Cattle Committee, reserves the right to order immediate removal from the Showground of any animal it considers unruly or unmanageable. Exhibitors expelled from the Showgrounds are not entitled to any refund of entry fees.

Greenfeed

C.25: The Canterbury A&P Association will endeavour to provide sufficient quantities of greenfeed to Livestock Exhibitors at the event. The Canterbury A&P Association takes no responsibility for providing greenfeed in excess of what is deemed adequate for each section.

ALL CATTLE MUST HAVE A NAIT TAG AND THE OFFICIAL PRIMARY & SECONDARY EAR TAGS IN THEIR EAR.

No entry fee. Entries on Official Entry Form to be submitted by general cut-off date.
No entries will be taken on the day.

This competition is for the purpose of educating cattle exhibitors, attendants and assistants to parade exhibits before a judge in the most efficient manner and to learn the skill of judging cattle. Open to competitors to the age of 24 inclusive, with age being stated on entry form. Age as of 1st July in year of competition.

STEER COMPETITION: There will be no steer competitions, yearling or two year old, for 2020. Any exhibitor/entrant may bring a steer for the youth paraders competitions, this animal must be entered on the entry form to ensure NAIT compliance and pen allocations.

BEEF STOCK JUDGING

The Association will provide ribbons for top place getters. No more than 2 classes (A & B) of 4 animals of the same age to be judged on a virtual platform – the Canterbury Youth Showing Facebook Page.

Placings for classes A & B to be given in written form. Verbal reasons for placings to be given on class A via video direct message to be submitted to Sarah O'Connell. Videos will be judged by the class/breed over judge.

Judging will take place from the 1st of November to the 5th of November. Videos of animals to be judged will be posted online the morning of the 1st. Send your placings for both classes plus a video giving your reasons for your placings for class A via Facebook direct message to Sarah O'Connell. Do not post your video on the open Facebook Page.

Please note these instructions are subject to change, please keep an eye on the Facebook Page for updates.

JUNIOR BEEF PARADERS

The Association will provide ribbons for top place getters. Novice sections within the age group sections: Novices must not have competed more than THREE times in EITHER Paraders or Stock Judging Competitions run at official A&P Shows. Unregistered cattle and steers can be paraded.

Competitors must lead the animals which must be aged between one and two years old, steers are acceptable within the age categories. The animal is not to be judged other than on presentation and general appearance. One judge shall decide each competition.

- Class 7741 Novice Junior Beef aged 8 and under 14 years at 1st July 2020 - Calves or yearling cattle to be used.

BEEF INTERSCHOOLS PARADERS COMPETITION

Open to all schools in NZ to be run in conjunction with the existing paraders classes. The competition is set up for exhibitors to adopt a school to help handle their cattle at the Show and in return the school members learn showmanship and also have the opportunity to enter the beef



paraders, stock judging and the inter-school competitions. Open to all schools but schools can combine to make a team. **No entry fee.**

Entry to be submitted by ONE team member only, team member names do not need to be stated.

A minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 in the team for the competition. Age of cattle needs to be the same for each member of the same team. Any beef breed is acceptable - with the exclusion that primary school teams may have dairy/beef cross bred animals.

To be judged in 2 parts:

1. School to parade animals at the conclusion of the herdsperson competition, to be judged as a team. School to identify themselves with a uniform, eg: school caps, ties, rugby jersey, uniform etc. They will be judged on the standard of their dress. School management may specify.
2. Best-kept school stall. Could also be the best-kept stall of the Beef Section of the Show.
