#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

##### Number holders may be worn or back numbers available on the day.

1. All Horses and Ponies are eligible to compete in one nominated inhand section and one nominated ridden section, with the exception of exhibits used in the Lead Rein and First Ridden section. Pony used in Lead Rein may be used in First Ridden. Pony used in other ridden sections may NOT be also used in First Ridden.
2. Applications for refunds must be in writing and accompanied by a doctor/ vet certificate and will be refunded at 80% of the total entry fee.
3. Protests must be in writing and lodged within 10mins of class completion with \$50 – which will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
4. Inhand exhibit may be presented in a bridle with the exception of the miniature horses who are shown in show halters.
5. Novice exhibit must be ridden in a snaffle bit or similar. No Pelham bits or double bridles in Novice classes.
6. Novice exhibit is one that has not won 6 firsts in any Show at the time of the show. Once a Horse/Pony has had 6 wins at any Show, it is not eligible for novice classes. Novice exhibits can be entered in open classes. Performance cards may be required to view. Novice ponies may be ridden by any age of rider. Open pony exhibits must be ridden by riders under 17 years of age.
7. Lead Rein classes are restricted to riders under 8 years of age with a minimum age of 4 years. First Ridden Classes are restricted to riders under 10 years of age who are not competing in any other section.
8. Ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place.
9. All sections have a minimum of 5 entries and may be capped at 15 entries per class for ridden sections.
10. Height certificates are not enforced, but should be carried if the judge queries exhibit eligibility.
11. No classes will be held up except for Championships which will be at the Head Steward's discretion.
12. A steward can order an exhibit considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horse from the ring without recourse from the owner/ competitor/ exhibitor.
13. No colts or stallions are permitted to compete on pony club grounds under the ruling by Ashburton Pony Clubs.
14. The use of audio equipment of any kind or device between the sideline and a competitor is strictly forbidden.
15. The committee will not be held responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused to or suffered by any animal, person or property.
16. The committee reserves the right to make alteration to the programme, postpone or cancel the show as it sees fit.
17. Manure around floats must be picked up. It may be deposited at the base of a tree.
18. Safety approved and tagged helmets must be worn by all competitors with 3 point harness and meeting current safety standards.
19. No dogs allowed on the grounds. If the organisers have to leave their dogs home, the exhibitors can do likewise.
20. Chest number holders may be used. Back numbers will be made available if you do not have a number holder.
21. Late entries after the close of entries will be charged a penalty of an additional 100% of the entry fee to cover extra administrative work.
22. All internet payments must be paid prior to close of entries to Mill Creek Pony Club 03-1351-0331762-00. Please use MCPC Show as code and entrants surname as reference.
23. Back numbers will be posted to Facebook or in show day catalogue which will be emailed to competitors.
24. Age of rider is as of date of show.
25. Age of exhibit is of 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2020.

Entry fee is \$4 per class. Late entries (\$8 per class) will be accepted but must be paid before 7:30am for morning classes and before 11am for the afternoon classes

Inhand showing classes 8.30am to 10.15am, Pony ridden 10.30am to 12.15pm. Lunch Break 12.15pm to 12.45pm. Horse ridden 12.45pm to 2.30pm.

The organisers reserve the right to alter the judges, classes, rings and schedule of time at their discretion should entry numbers deem it necessary. All reasonable steps will be taken to ensure the smooth running of the show and competitors will be notified of such changes as soon as practicable.
