Rules and Regulations – Conditions of Entry

- **IMPORTANT: ONE ENTRY FORM PER COMPETITOR**
- This is a legal document. The owner/parent/guardian signing or authorising the entry must be 18 years or over.
- Horse and pony competitors may purchase an RAS Equestrian Judges & Competitors Rule Book from RAS, PO Box 54, Woodend, North Canterbury 7641.
- The attention of exhibitors is particularly drawn to the conditions relating to the misuse of substances, and the intention of the Committee to undertake testing for forbidden substances.
- RAS approved helmets must be worn by all riders and also must have a current red tag.
- Height and Performance certificates for Horse classes are to be carried at all times.
- Novice & Open Classification: A novice horse/pony or rider is one that has yet to win 6 classes in any division within the competitions provided at any A& P Show. The number of novice wins is to be counted at the time of the Show, not the entry.
- District competition means and includes any person and horse whose permanent home is in the area of the old Banks Peninsula District Council.
