Judging

Menzies Cup judging commences at 8.30am and ends at 12 noon sharp.

Judges may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances.

This show supports the RAS yellow card system.

Measuring/Back Numbers

Measuring on the grounds (for District only horses) will be available on Saturday morning at 7.30am. Competitors/exhibitors obtaining temporary measuring certificates must live in the defined Show District boundary.

No back number will be issued unless a height certificate (temporary or permanent) is produced and all entry fees are paid in full.

Grand Parade

All horse section prize winners must participate in the Grand Parade held immediately at completion of morning horse events (approx. 12 noon).

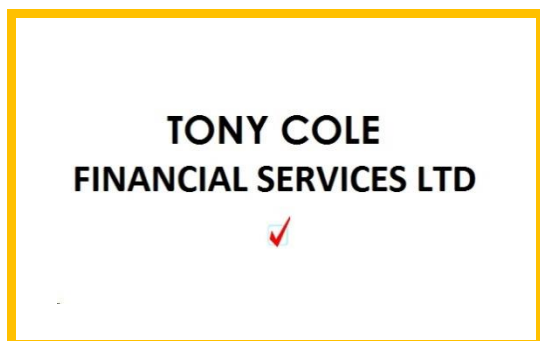
